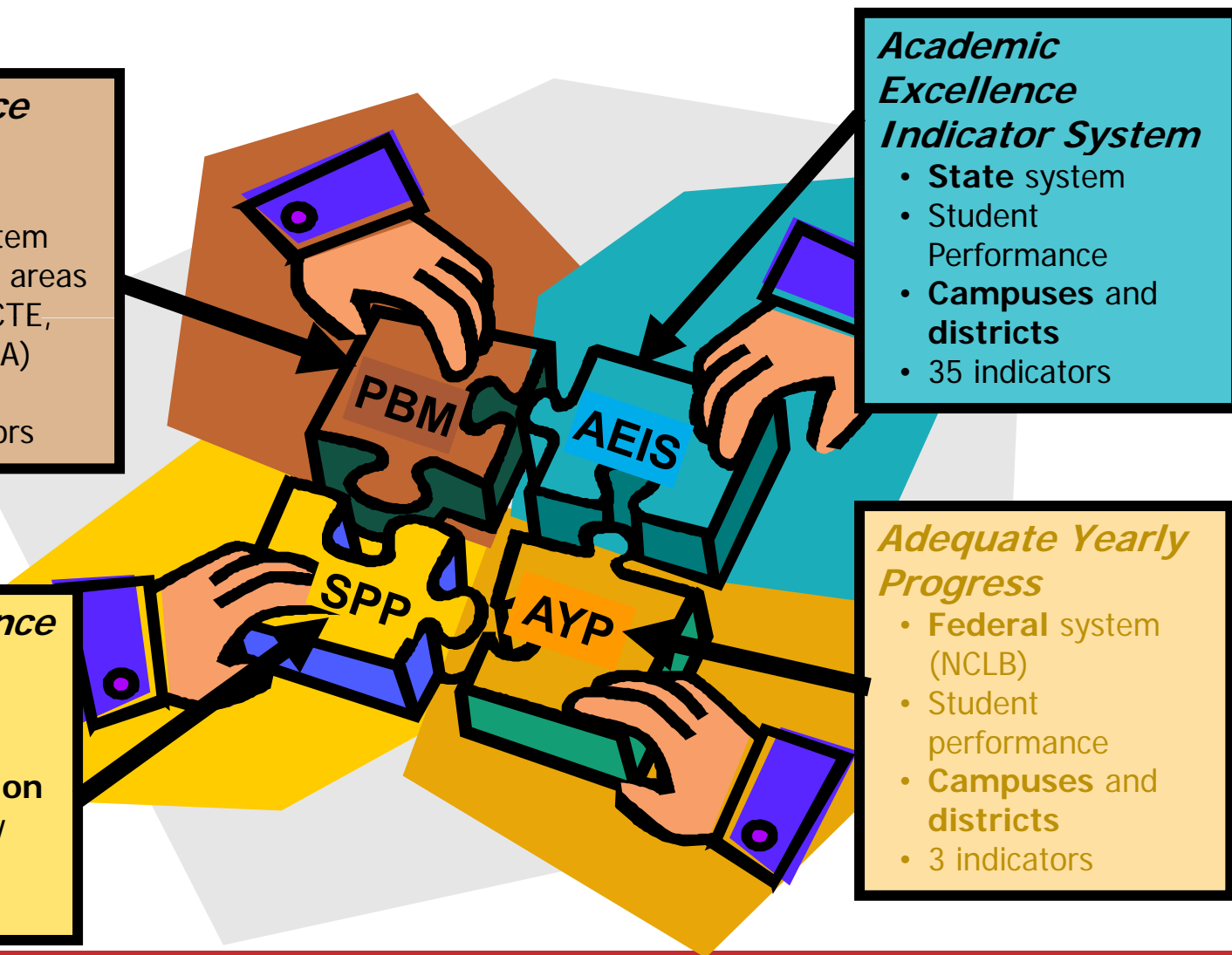

Academic Excellence Indicator System (AEIS)



- Comprehensive reporting system defined by statute
- Published annually since 1990-91
- Gives parents and community a snapshot of
 - District and Campus Performance
 - District and Campus Profile
- Contains all data used to determine District accountability ratings
- Uses data collected through:
 - State data reporting system (PEIMS)
 - Student assessment system

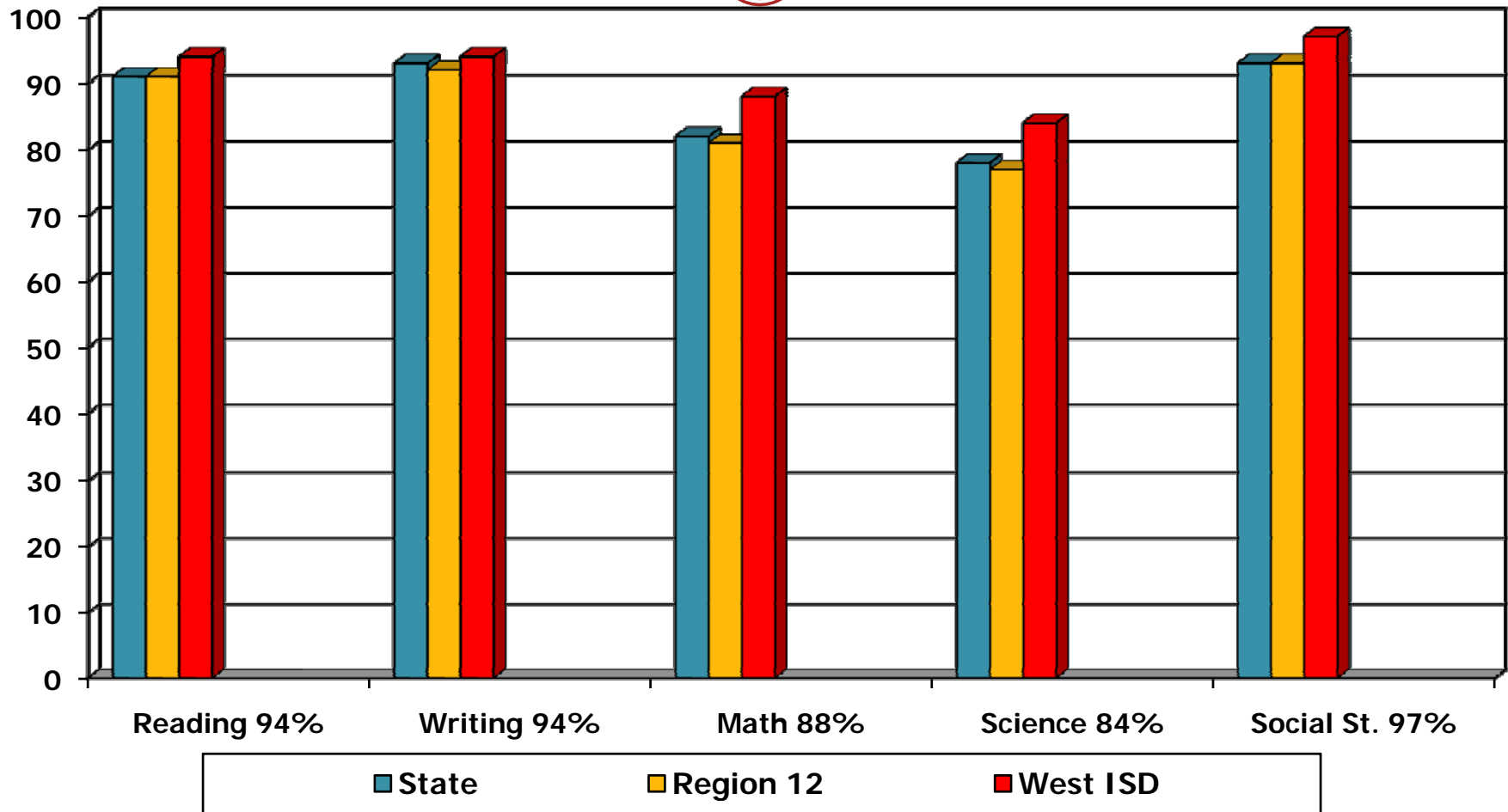

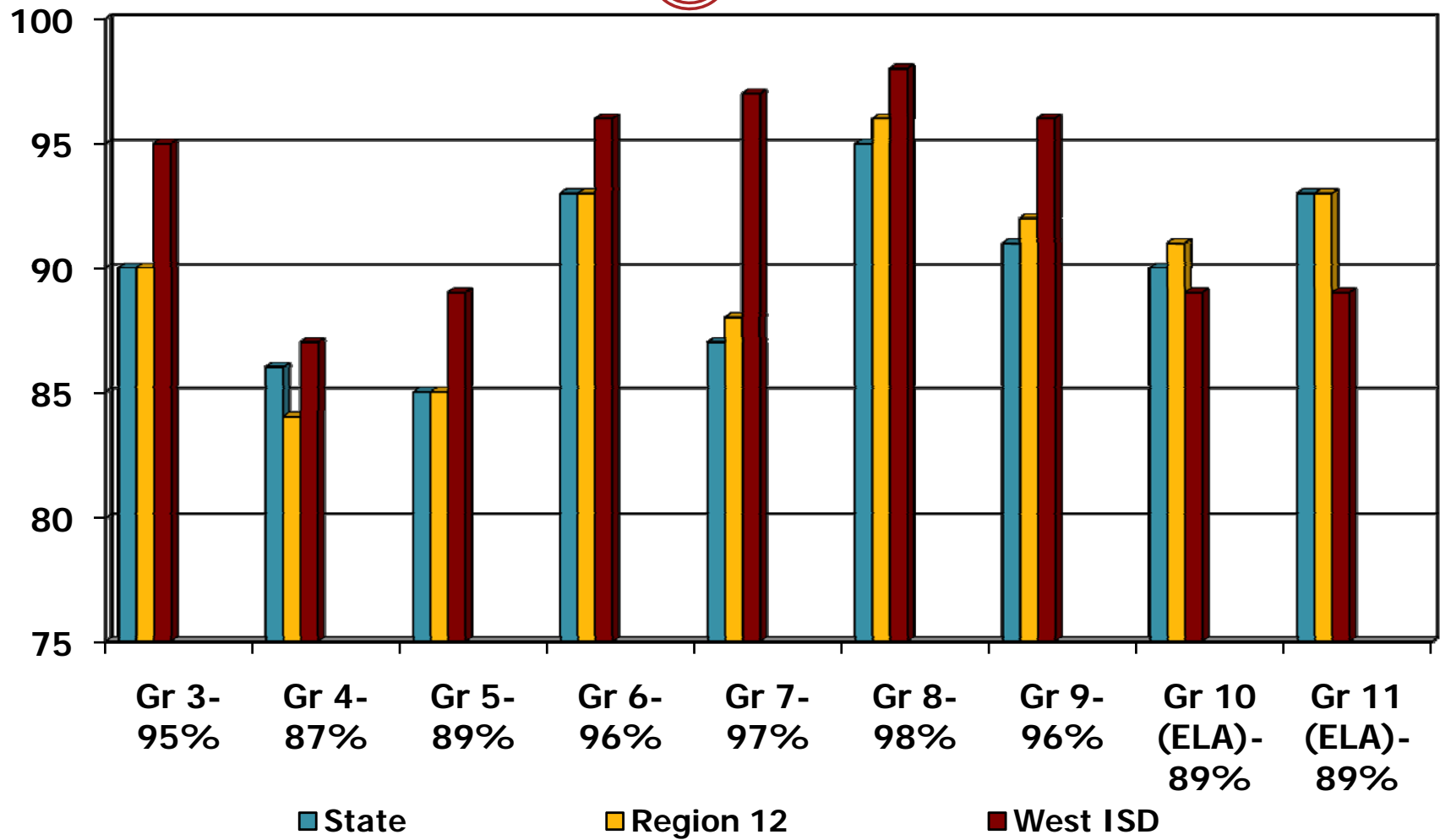

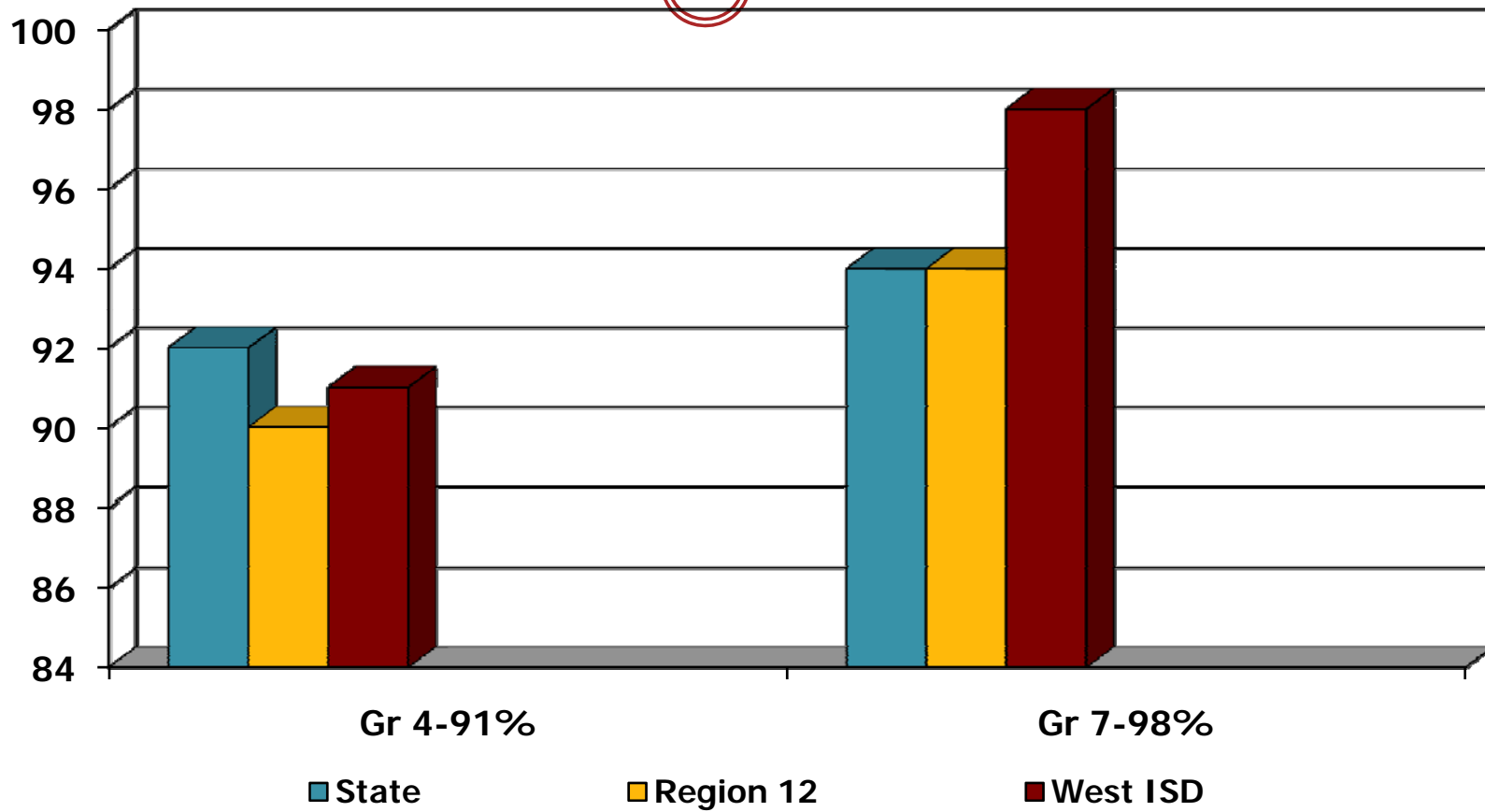
Sum of All Grades Tested - **2009 Accountability Indicator**



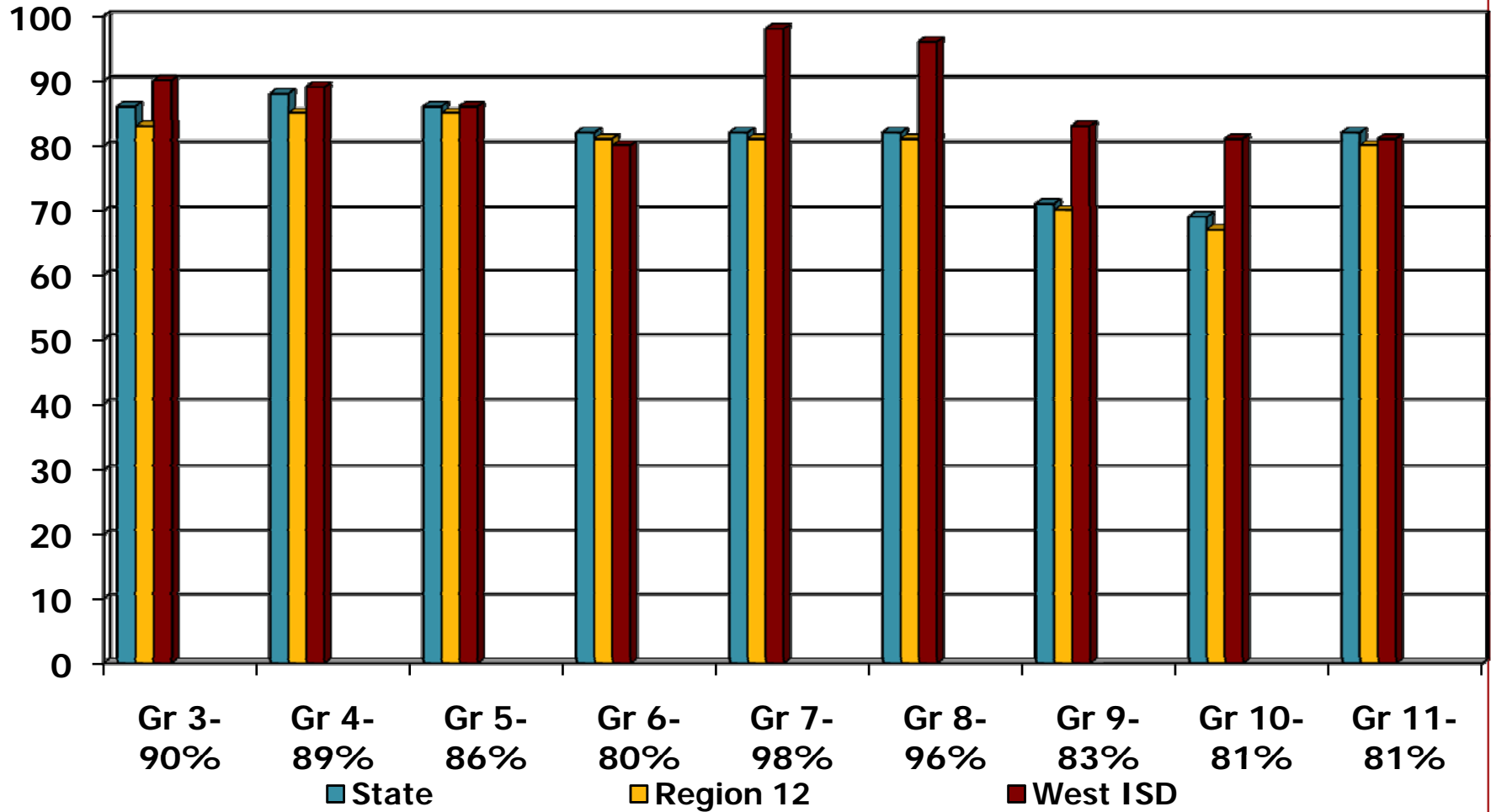
2009 TAKS Performance Reading/English Language Arts



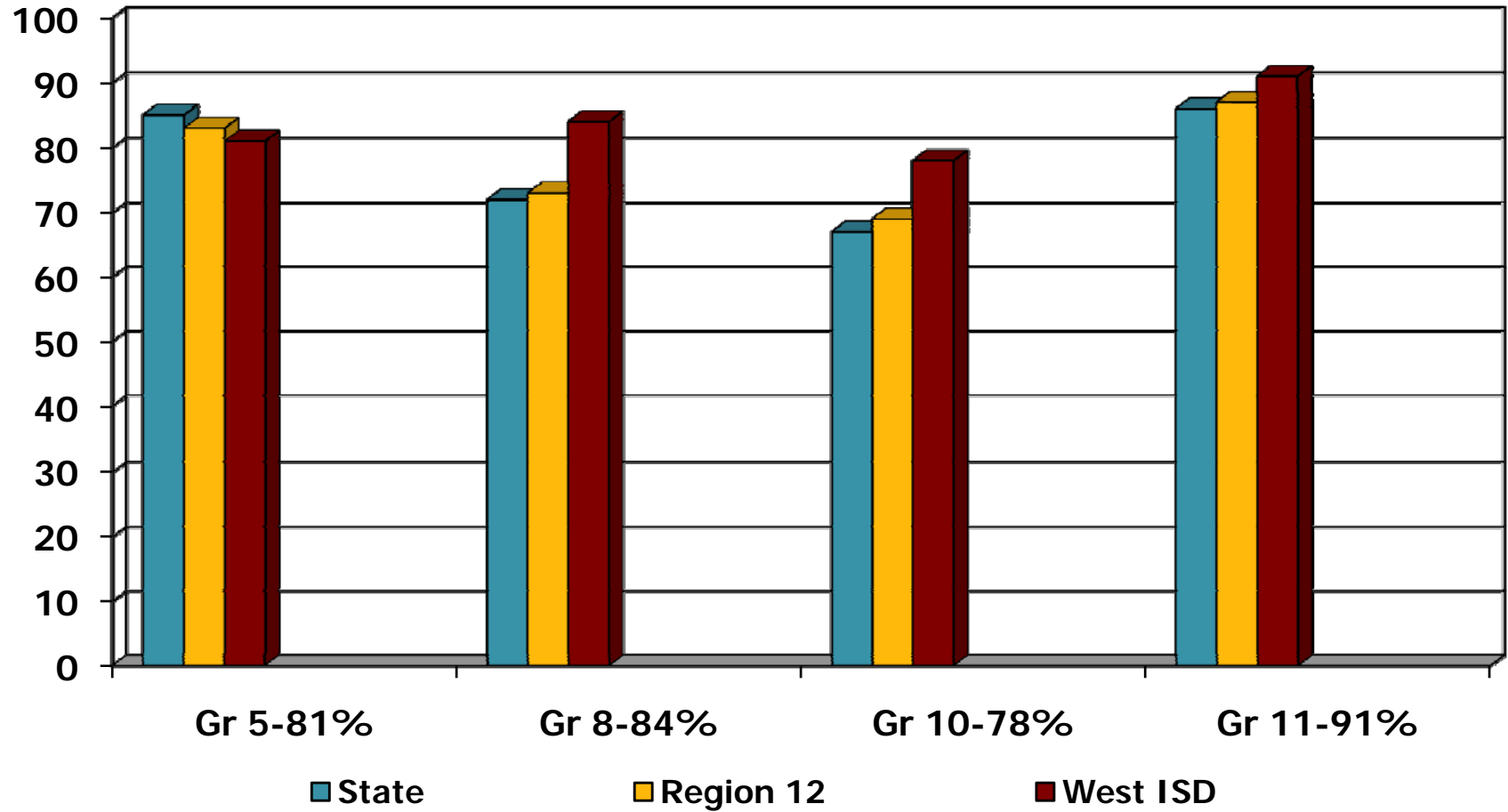
2009 TAKS Performance Writing



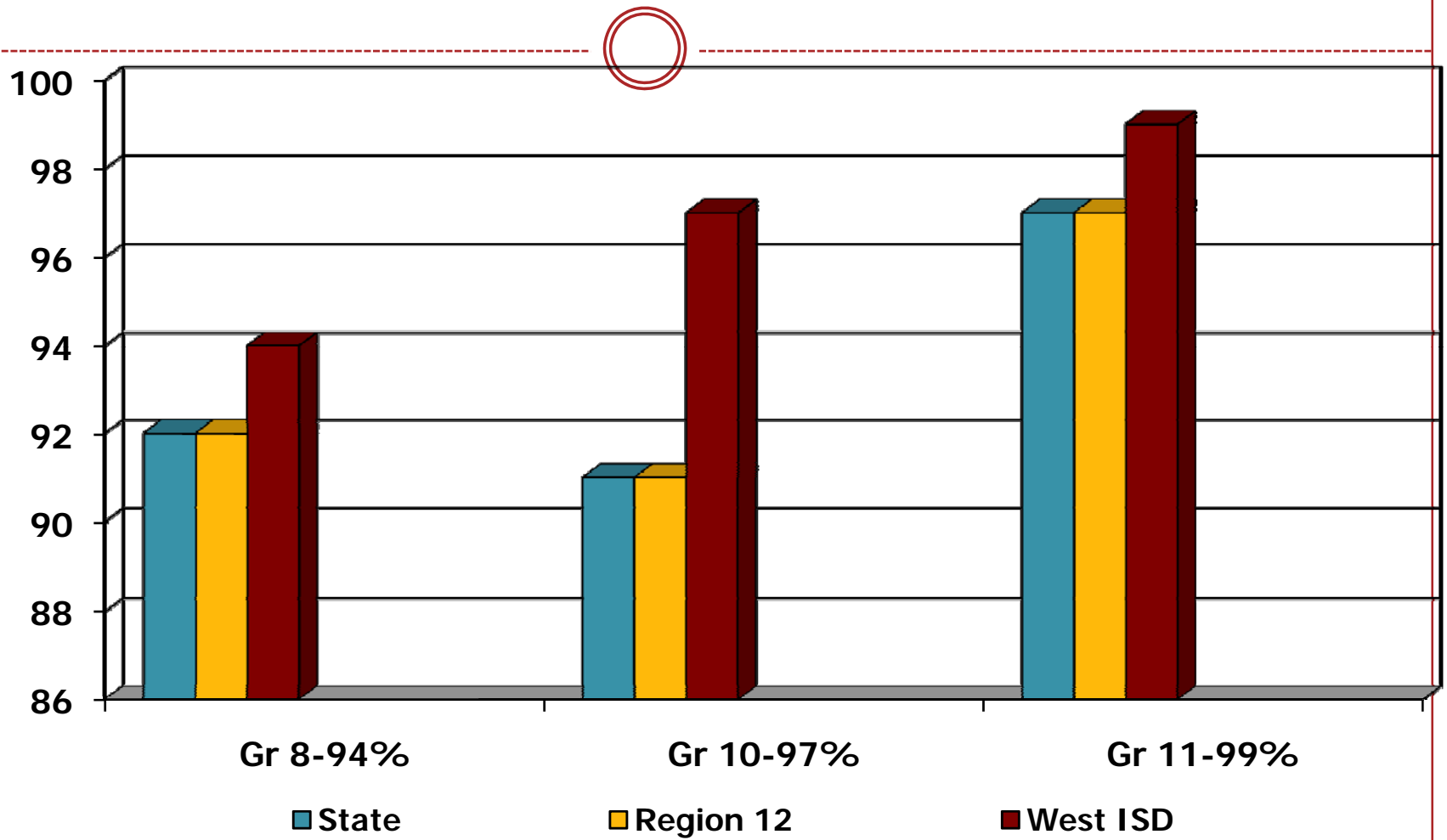
2009 TAKS Performance Mathematics



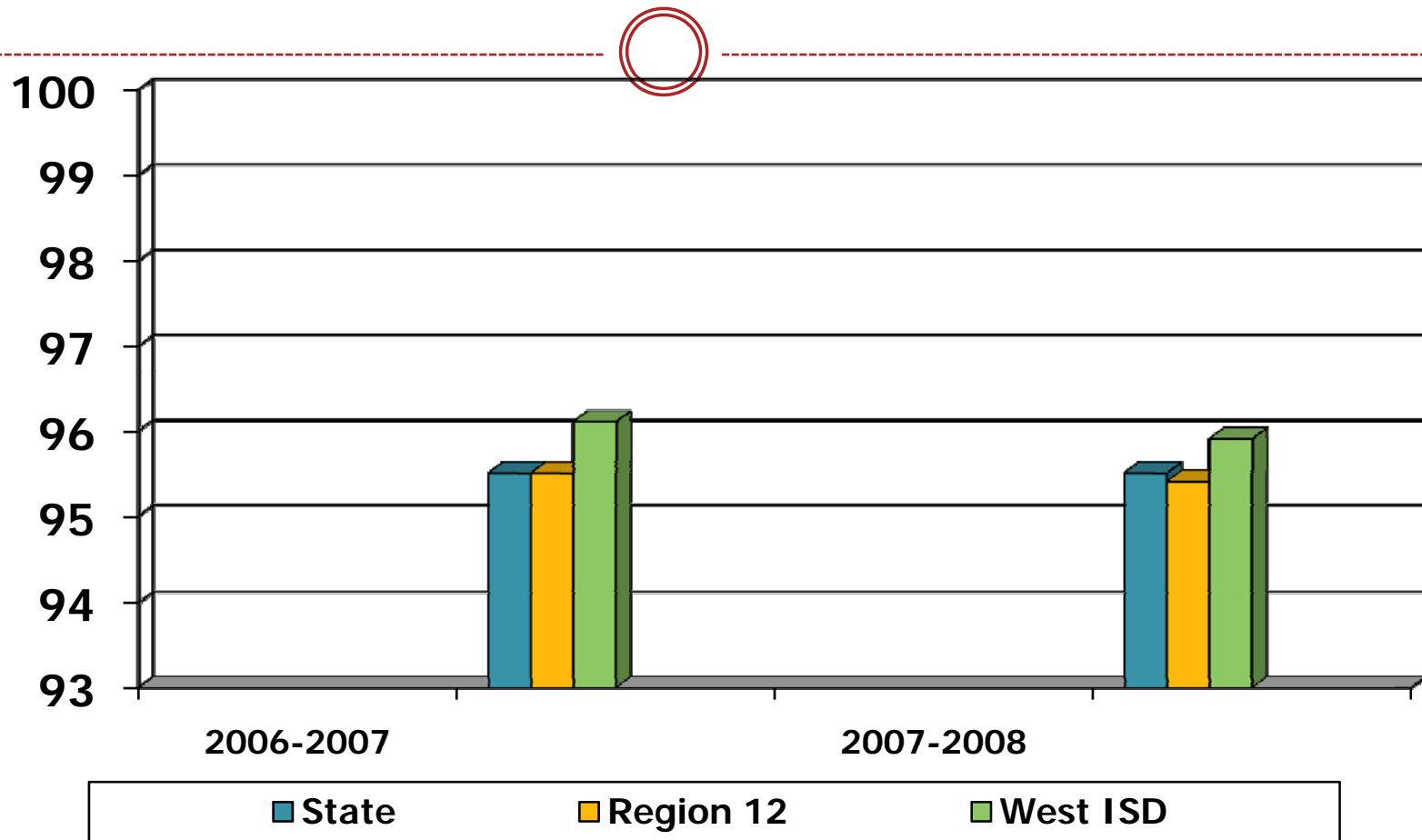

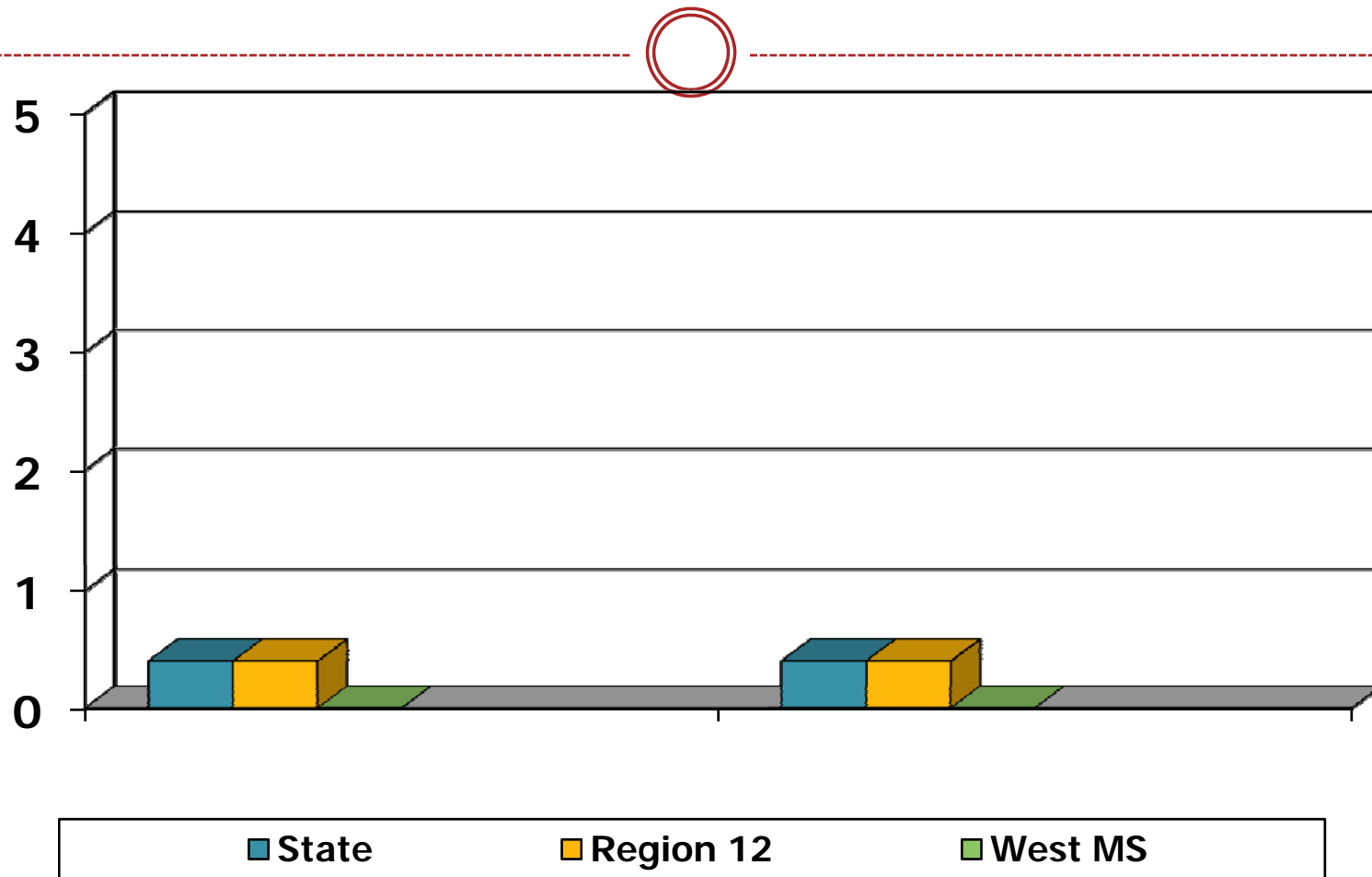


2007-08 Attendance (Year Behind)



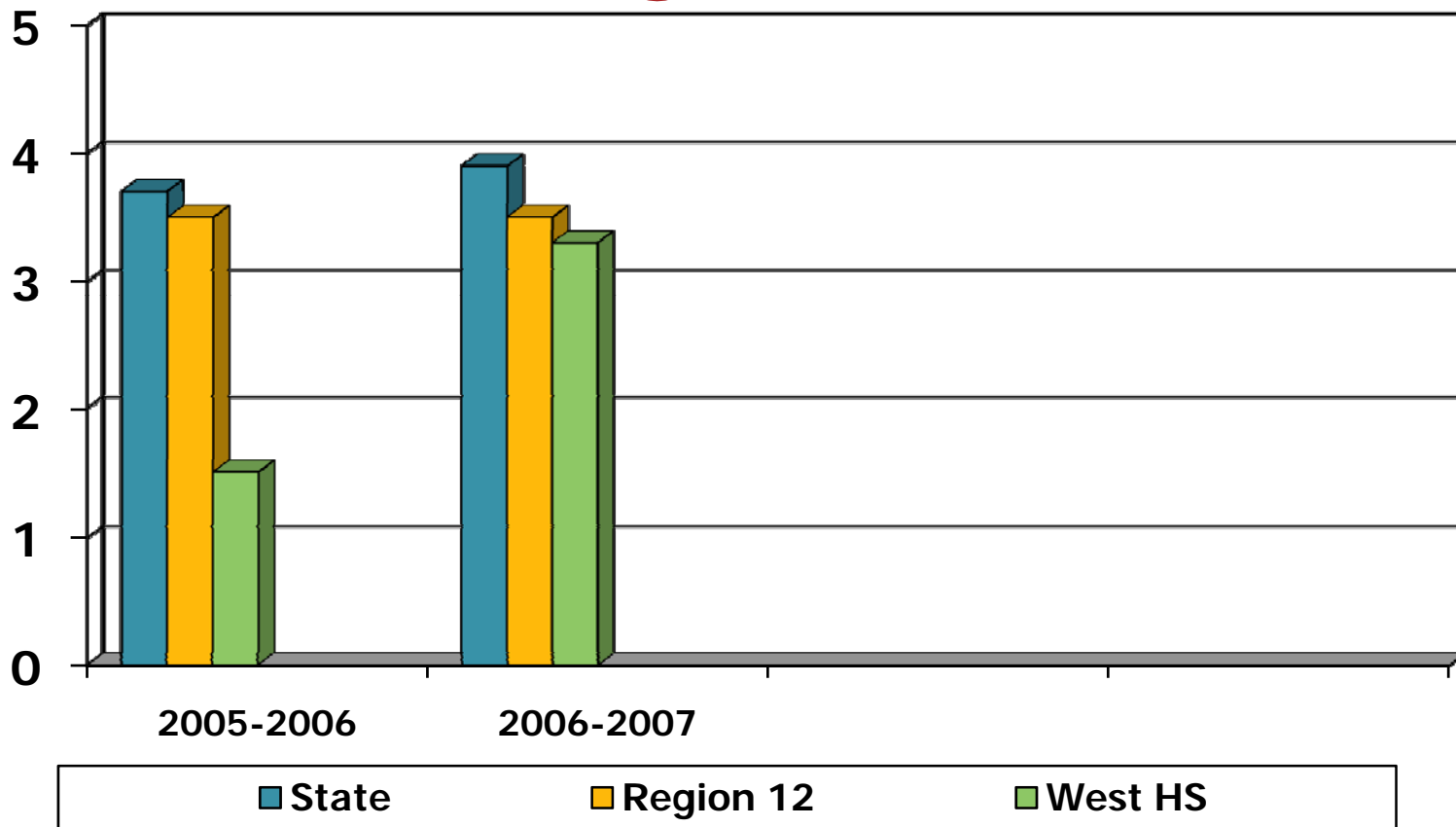

2007-08 Annual Dropout Rate (Gr. 7-8)



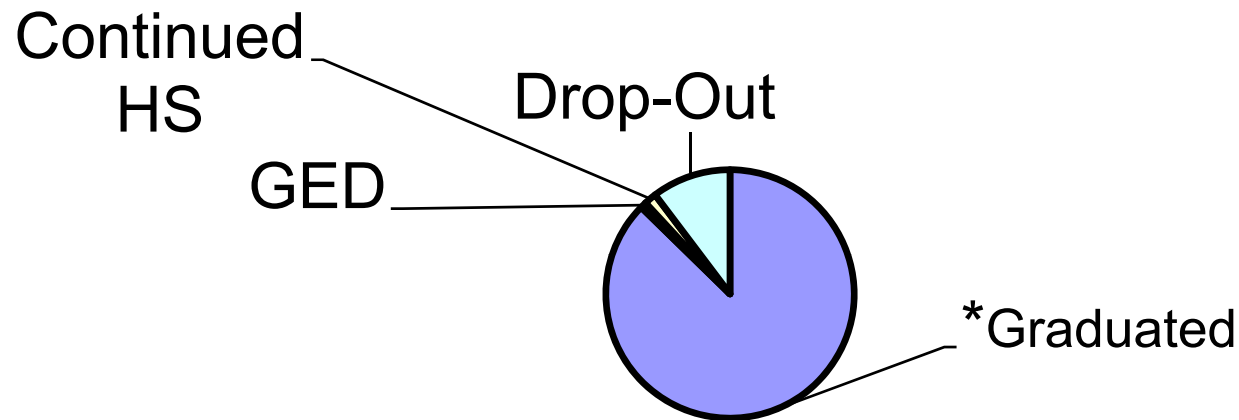
